JUTH FC plans to build new stadium

JUTH FC have concluded plans to build a new stadium in Jos, Plateau state with adequate support from the Nigeria Football League (NFL). Chief Medical Director of the Teaching Hospital Dr. Ishaya Pam said they will need assistance from the NFL as they have already approached the Plateau State government for a piece of land.

"We have forwarded our application for allocation of piece of land to the governor of Plateau State through the commissioner for lands, survey and town planning and it is presently receiving attention," Pam said.

NFL chairman, Oyulki Obaseki told Kick Off that the

League board have not wavered in its commitment to build stadiums across the country in collaboration with Premier League clubs.

"It is our plan to build five thousand seat stadiums for Premier League clubs that have Certificates of Occupancy (C of O) on plots of land."

"The stadiums will have such facilities like hostels, three bedroom bungalows for team officials and technical crew and a functional clinic, press hall, standby generating set and flood light."

The NFL board has fixed July for the inspection of the plot of land in Jos and will pay visit to the Plateau State governor, Jonah Jang.
