





FEMI FALANA, SAN - BRIEF PROFILE



Femi Falana was born on May 20th, 1958, in Ilawe, Ekiti State, Nigeria. He is an erudite lawyer, a Senior Advocate of Nigeria and a renowned Human Rights Activist. He was a student of St. Michael's Primary School, Ilawe, from 1963 to 1968. After his primary education, he attended Sacred Heart Catholic Seminary from 1971 to 1975.

From 1977 to 1981, he studied at the Obafemi Awolowo University and graduated in flying colors.

Falana began his legal practice career in 1982. In the year 1991, he floated his own Chambers which he then called Femi Falana & Co. now, Falana and Falana Chambers, having his wife Funmi as a partner. Having excelled in his law practice, he was elevated to the prestigious rank of Senior Advocate of Nigeria in the year 2012.

Falana is a known human right activist in Nigeria. He became a human rights defender long before his qualification as a lawyer, judging by his know several activist roles, even as a student in the University. He also contested and lost the governorship election of Ekiti State in 2007 on the platform of National Conscience Party, a party he served as National Chairman in 2011.






